



Deschutes Recycling Guide

Glass – Recycle in designated location

Clear and Colored Glass Bottles & Jars. Rinse clean. Labels are okay.
No need to separate by color. No dishes, glasses, ceramics or window glass.

Corrugated Cardboard - Recycle in designated location

Flatten. *No waxed or slick coated cardboard. No Styrofoam or any packing material.*

Newspaper - Recycle in designated location

Newspaper only. Anything that comes in the newspaper can be recycled with the newspaper. *No plastic bags, string or banding.*

Comingle Materials - Recycle in designated location

• Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, Phonebooks

• Plastics – Rinse clean. No liquid, motor oil or hazardous waste in containers. No need to flatten.

YES – Only These Plastics:

Plastic bottles, tubs and jugs (6 ounces or larger), milk jugs, water bottles, shampoo bottle.

Rigid plastic tubs such as yogurt containers, sour cream & cottage cheese containers and butter tubs.

Rigid nursery plant pots (4 inches or larger), plastic buckets (5 gallons or less).

NO – Unacceptable Plastics:

Examples (but not inclusive) of unacceptable plastics; plastic bags, plastic film (saran wrap, sandwich bags, zip lock bags), clear plastic clamshells (bakery and produce containers), takeout food containers, packaging, bubble wrap, plastic foodware (cups, plates, utensils), toys.

• Tin/Aluminum – Cans, jar lids, foil, TV dinner trays and beverage cans. Rinse clean. No need to flatten.

• Paper Bags

• Mixed Paper & Junk Mail – Paper, envelopes, white & colored paper, computer paper, tin can labels, wrapping paper (*no foil or ribbon*), shredded paper (strips only, *no confetti*). *No paper ream wrappers, tissue paper, waxed paper, candy wrappers, snack food bags.*

• Paperboard – Cereal/cracker/shoe boxes (*discard liners*), soda & beer cartons, paper egg cartons, paper towel tubes. *No frozen food boxes, paper cups/plates/towels/napkins, pet food bags.*

Wood Waste - Recycle in designated location

• Decking, fencing, used lumber, plywood, particle board, pallets, crates.

• Clean building lumber straps, engineered wood. Nails and staples are accepted.

• *Not Accepted: treated lumber, painted lumber, metal clad wood, vinyl siding, plastic lumber or laminates, railroad ties, metal fasteners (bolts, heavy hinges, steel rods, cable, joist hangers), furniture or trash of any kind.*

Yard Debris - Recycle in designated location

“IF IT GROWS, IT GOES!”

• Grass clippings, brush, plant prunings, pine needles, pine cones, weeds, trimmings and branches, stumps or trees (no larger than 12” diameter).

• Sod and clean dirt (separate from yard debris).

• *Not Accepted: rocks, lumber, metal, trash or plastics of any kind, including plastic bags.*

Used Motor Oil

Cooking Oil - one gallon jugs only

Clean Scrap Metal

Propane Tanks

Automotive Batteries

Rechargeable Batteries (no alkaline batteries)

BBQ's (no tank)

Lawnmowers (all fluids removed)

Paint – latex and oil paints and stains only (up to 10 containers). No dried paint, spray cans, thinners and solvents, open, leaking, or empty containers. Please dispose of dried paint and empty containers in the trash.

E-Waste

Computers, Laptops, Monitors, TVs, Keyboards, Mice, and Printers (desktop).....No Charge

All Other Electronic Components including Peripherals such as:

- Speakers, Disc Drives, Faxes,
- Diagnostic Test Equipment, Point of Sale Equipment,
- Telephone Equipment, Cell Phones, Digital Cameras, Radios, VCR's, DVD's,
- Projectors and Copy Machines:
